And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. King James Version (KJV)

**REMEMBER THIS FROM THESE SCRIPTURES:**

- Continue to be led by the Spirit
- Studying/Prayer/Fasting/Assembly Yourself

## Four Steps to a New Life

**STEP 1 – ACCEPT GOD'S LOVE**

Accepting God's love is the first step in your new life. God loves you so much that He gave His only son to die just for you.

**JOHN 3:16-19 READS:**

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil." King James Version (KJV)

**REMEMBER THIS FROM THESE SCRIPTURES:**

- God Loves You
- The reason you are condemned
- The reason Jesus came – To save us from condemnation

**STEP 2 – ACCEPT JESUS**

Accept Jesus Christ into your life. He wants to be everything you need him to be.

**ROMANS 10:9-10 READS:**

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart

that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.” King James Version (KJV)

**REMEMBER THIS FROM THESE SCRIPTURES:**

- Confess means to agree with God that Jesus is Lord, your boss.
- Believe that Jesus is alive
- That what is in your heart will come out of your mouth.

**STEP 3 – INVITE JESUS INTO YOUR HEART**

Invite Jesus into your heart. Just ask him and he will come.

**REVELATION 3:20 READS:**

“Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.” King James Version (KJV)

**Pray and ask Jesus to come into your heart.**

**REMEMBER THIS FROM THESE SCRIPTURES:**

- The door is the door to your heart
- To sup means to Dine (Develop a Relationship)

**STEP 4 – BAPTISM**

Baptism, a fresh start to your new life.

**MARK 16:16 READS:**

“He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.” King James Version (KJV)

**REMEMBER THIS FROM THESE SCRIPTURES:**

- Water Baptism marks the end of the old life and the beginning of your new life in Jesus Christ.

# Four Steps to the Holy Ghost

**STEP 1 – REPENT: ACTS 2:38-39**

“Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the LORD our God shall call.” King James Version (KJV)

**REMEMBER THIS FROM THESE SCRIPTURES:**

- Repent – (Christ Glorified)
- You Shall Receive
- This Promise is to ALL

**STEP 2 – BELIEVE: ST JOHN 7:37-39**

“In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

(But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)” King James Version (KJV)

**REMEMBER THIS FROM THESE SCRIPTURES:**

- Thirst. You must have the desire
- Drink. Your desire caused you to drink
- Believe and you shall receive

**STEP 3 – RECEIVE: ACTS 2:1-4**

And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.
